October 2015 is a special month for SAGS as we enter into the peak winter season with more airline customers at both Tan Son Nhat Airport (SGN) and Da Nang Airport (DAD).

The month starts with the inaugural flight of Nok Air. The Thailand-based carrier kicks off with 04 flights weekly by Boeing B737-800 routing Tan Son Nhat Airport, Ho Chi Minh City and Don Mueang Airport, Bangkok.

Nok Air plans to increase the frequency to twice daily within December 2015, offering more chances to leisure travel to Thailand.

SAGS is appointed as the carrier's comprehensive ground service provider supporting passenger, ramp and aircraft handling services.

The first flight has been cordially welcomed with a cordial & colorful event at the check-in counter.

Midnight 25 October, Jin Air's first flight landed at Da Nang Airport (DAD) at 00:20+ carrying 170 passengers. The departure was 6 minutes to STD and handled without a hitch.

With group photo session on the apron, fresh flower wreaths were presented to the crew to mark this special occasion.

As a subsidiary of Korean Air and the latest Korea-based airline in operation at DAD, Jin Air will mount daily flight from Incheon Airport, Seoul to Vietnam's tourism hub by Boeing B737-800 and Boeing B777 as alternate aircraft type.

The carrier is considering adding flights from Kimhae Airport, Busan to Vietnam in the Winter Season 2015 with similar aircraft.
