Freighter operations

The first half of 2016 witnessed the high growth rate for both freighter and passenger operations at Tan Son Nhat Int'l Airport (SGN) and Da Nang Int'l Airport (DAD).



In March, Qatar Cargo launched its first freighter to the station with 02 flights weekly by Airbus A330F connecting Doha to Ho Chi Minh City.



In May, Turkish Cargo operated 01 flight per week by Airbus A330F.

Other cargo carriers are planning to mount additional flights to the busy hub of Ho Chi Minh City.

New passenger flights

Kia ora ! We welcomed Air New Zealand's maiden flight in June. Now, it's the first time that travellers could have the wonderful experience with the direct flight connecting Ho Chi Minh City to Auckland. Air New Zealand is now flying 03 flights weekly by Boeing B767.

In Da Nang Int'l Airport (DAD), May and June are extremely busy months as we are honored to service 02 new carriers: Bangkok Airways and T'way Air.

Bangkok Airways is now having 04 flights per week by Airbus A319 / A320 carrying leisure passengers from Bangkok to Da Nang City.

T'way Air – the Korean-based airline – has started routing Da Nang and Seoul effective from June 2016, joining the massive influx of airlines from Korea. The carrier operates 04 flights per week by Boeing B737.
