The Star Alliance member has operated Hong Kong – Ho Chi Minh City route on board Boeing B747 at the beginning and subsequently B737 in recent years on daily basis.

October 29 witnessed UNITED’s last operation to Tan Son Nhat International Airport, Ho Chi Minh City.
